


Goal of ACHIEVE

To demonstrate the impact of implementation strategies on the adoption and implementation of the outpatient hypertension bundle in settings that reach birthing people at the greatest risk for maternal morbidity and mortality

The Implementation Team

At a minimum needs to include-

- -Medical Assistant (or equivalent)
- -Nurse
- –ProviderChampion

Expectations

Clinic

- Select a provider champion
- Establish implementation team
- Schedule and Participate in trainings and simulations
- Schedule and Participate in blood pressure observations
- Participate in quality improvement activities
- Sustain improvement

Implementation Team

- Schedule and Participate in coaching sessions
- Tailor protocols to your clinic setting
- Disseminate patient education materials
- Develop / revise policies and procedures to adhere to guidelines
- Participate in data collection surveys and interviews
- Plan how to sustain improvement

Time Requirements of the Clinic Staff and Providers

Who	Activity	How	Anticipated time required (estimated)
Medical support personnel (eg MAs, CNAs)	Blood Pressure Observation	ACHIEVE staff will observe technique for measuring BP (w/standardized patient)	15-minutes per observation
Medical support personnel (eg MAs, CNAs)	Blood Pressure Training	ACHIEVE staff will provide training on technique for measuring BP	30-45-minute meeting or asynchronous review of video
All clinical staff	Training on recognition and response to severe HTN in perinatal patients	ACHIEVE staff provide training on the outpatient hypertension bundle and clinic specific algorithm	60-minute meeting or asynchronous review of video
Implementation team (provider, nurse, MSP)	Coaching Sessions	Meetings with ACHIEVE nurse coordinator in person or virtually;	60-minute meetings held monthly
Providers with care team (MA, CNA, nurse)	Simulations	ACHIEVE team facilitates simulations of patient presenting with severe hypertension in the outpatient clinic	30-minutes per simulation
Implementation team (provider, nurse MSP)	Surveys, interviews and/or focus groups	ACHIEVE staff will conduct these activities in person or virtually regarding implementation strategies	15-20 minutes per survey, interview or focus group


- Training and feedback on blood pressure technique


